##### **Uniform**

A higher standard of dress encourages greater respect for individual students and results in a higher standard of behavior. Our dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school dress for normal school days. **The administration at Coweta Charter Academy at Senoia reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/or make changes as necessary during the school year.** Students are expected to follow these guidelines. A school uniform shall be worn by every student in attendance.

**All uniforms must be purchased through the uniform vendor and embroidered with proper school logos. Uniforms that are altered for length (other than pant legs), belt loops, etc. will be considered a uniform violation. Uniforms may not be purchased nor monogrammed at any other location. The approved school vendors are J&R Clothing which is located in Fayetteville, Georgia and online uniform source, All Uniform Wear.**

**Shoes:** Students must wear closed heel and closed toe shoes at all times. No sandals, CROCs, heels, flip-flops, heavy military type boots or shoes with metal tips may be worn. All shoes must have non-marking soles.

**Socks:** If socks are worn, they must be **Solid white, khaki, black or navy in color.**

**Tights:** Plain white, red, or navy blue tights may be worn under skirts, skorts, or jumpers. **Leggings are not permitted.**

**Traditional Polo Shirts:** All students are required to wear polo shirts bearing the school logo. These shirts must be worn every day to school with the exception of Spirit Days. Middle School student shirts are **navy or white** with the school emblem embroidered. A solid white or red long-sleeved undershirt may be worn under the school shirt. Students may also wear the approved long-sleeved school shirt. **All shirts, traditional uniform, PE and spirit wear must be tucked in throughout the day.**

**Pants/Shorts/Skorts/Jumpers:** Colors – Navy or Khaki with an embroidered CSUSA emblem. All uniform pants/shorts must be worn with a belt through the belt loops and worn at the waist. The belt must be in good repair. A black or brown belt must be worn at all times with any article of clothing that has belt loops. It should be fitted around the waist so that excess length can be tucked in loops and NOT hanging. Belts cannot have jewels, dangling items, large buckles, or logo/written items. Students are not permitted to wear sweatshirts and jackets tied around their waist. Girls are permitted to wear skorts. **All skorts and shorts must be of fingertip length. NO: cargo pants, capris, zip off style**

**pants or jeans of any color or style. DENIM BLUE jeans may be worn on designated days throughout the school year.**

**PE Attire:** Middle School students enrolled in PE are permitted to wear the approved PE Uniform, spirit wear or traditional uniform. The PE uniform consists of navy mesh shorts with the CCAS logo and a gray t-shirt with the same logo. Tennis shoes are required for PE. If a student chooses to wear the PE uniform or Spirit Wear, he/she will be expected to dress out (change) for PE. Facilities will be provided for students to change. Students will not be permitted to wear PE Uniforms for any classes other than PE. **Students may wear approved sweatshirts for outdoor PE or on Spirit Days only. Sweatshirts and “hoodies” will not be permitted on any other day.**

**Jackets:** Jackets and sweaters **worn inside the school building** must be embroidered with the school logo. Students will not be permitted to wear “hoodies” or sweatshirts inside the building other than on spirit days. Lightweight sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets that do not have an embroidered school logo shall be stored in bookbags for the day.

**Jewelry:** No body piercing other than earrings. Earrings should be stud-style only for safety purposes. Students may wear a watch and one thin necklace that is tucked into the shirt.

**General:** No sports bands (wrist, head or ankle) or scarves may be worn at school. At no time are students to wear anything offensive, immodest or deemed inappropriate by the faculty. **ALL CLOTHING SHOULD BE LABELED WITH THE STUDENT’S NAME.**

**Spirit Days:** Students will be allowed to wear **blue denim jeans** on selected Fridays for \$1.00 or with identified item donation (i.e., canned food goods). CCAS spirit shirts may be worn with jeans on Fridays. There will be Spirit theme days throughout the school year. Shirts, jerseys, sweatshirts will reflect the theme of the day.
