Uniform

A higher standard of dress encourages greater respect for individual students and results in a higher standard of behavior. Our dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school dress for normal school days. **Coweta Charter Academy at Senoia administration reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/or make changes during the school year.** Students are expected to follow these guidelines. A school uniform shall be worn by every student in attendance.

All uniforms must be purchased through the uniform vendor and embroidered with proper school logos. Uniforms that are altered for length (other than pant legs), belt loops, etc. will be considered a uniform violation. Uniforms may not be purchased nor monogrammed at any other location. The approved school vendors are J&R Clothing located in Fayetteville, Georgia and online uniform source, All Uniform Wear.

Shoes: Students must wear closed heel and closed toe shoes at all times. No sandals, CROCs, heels, flip-flops, heavy military type boots or shoes with metal tips may be worn. All shoes must have non-marking soles.

Socks: If socks are worn, they must be **Solid white, khaki, black or navy in color.**

Tights: Plain white, red, or navy blue tights may be worn under skirts, skorts, or jumpers. **Leggings are not permitted.**

Traditional Polo Shirts: Elementary School student shirts are Red. All shirts must be in the appropriate school colors with the school emblem embroidered. During cold weather season, a solid white undershirt, or color to match (red) may be worn under the school shirt. Students may also wear the approved long sleeve school shirt. All students are required to wear polo shirts bearing the school logo. **These shirts must be worn every day to school with the exception of Spirit Days. All shirts, traditional uniform, PE and spirit wear must be tucked in throughout the day.**

Slacks/Shorts/Skorts/Jumpers: Colors – Navy or Khaki with the CSUSA emblem embroidered. All uniform slacks/shorts must be worn with a belt through the belt loops, worn at the waist, and the belt must be in good repair. A black or brown belt must be worn at all times with any article of clothing as belt loops are essential. It should be fitted around the waist so that excess length can be tucked in loops and NOT hanging. Belts cannot have jewels, dangling items, large buckles, or logo/written items. Students are not permitted to wear sweatshirts and jackets tied around their waist. Girls are also permitted to wear

skorts. **All skorts and shorts must be one arms-length long.** Girls in grade K-5 may also wear navy or khaki jumpers. All jumpers must have the CCAS emblem embroidered. **NO: cargo pants, capris, zip off style pants or jeans of any color or style. DENIM BLUE Jeans may be worn on designated days throughout the school year.**

PE Attire: Tennis shoes are required for PE. K-5 students may wear the approved CCAS PE Uniform or Spirit Wear on PE days. **Students may wear approved sweatshirts for outdoor PE or on Spirit Days only. Sweatshirts and "hoodies" will not be permitted on any other day.**

Jackets: Jackets and sweaters worn inside the school building must have the school logo. Students will not be permitted to wear "hoodies" or sweatshirts inside the building other than on spirit days. ALL Middle School light weight sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets shall be stored in backpacks for the day. K-5 light weight sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets shall be stored in the classroom for the day.

Jewelry: No body piercing other than earrings. Earrings should be stud style only for safety purposes. Students may wear a watch and one thin necklace that is tucked into the shirt.

General: No sports bands (wrist, head or ankle) may be worn at school. At no time are students to wear anything offensive, immodest or deemed inappropriate by the faculty. **ALL CLOTHING SHOULD BE LABELED WITH THE STUDENT'S NAME.** Parents of students in Kindergarten are encouraged to leave a Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name with a spare change of clothes in their backpack throughout the year for emergencies.

Spirit Days: Students will be allowed to wear **blue denim jeans** on selected Fridays for \$1.00 or with identified item donation (i.e., canned food goods). CCAS spirit shirts may be worn with jeans on Fridays. There will be Spirit theme days throughout the school year. Shirts, jerseys, sweatshirts will reflect the theme of the day.
