



Appendix J Reassessment Policy

Coweta Charter Academy at Senoia does not retest grades, we reassess standards. Students who do not master standards at the 80% level on High Impact (30 pts) or Moderate-High Impact (20 pts) assignments have the opportunity to reassess for standards mastery. Modest Impact (5 points) and Moderate Impact (10 pts) will not be reassessed since the standards will appear on upper level assessments later. However, it should be used as a monitor to help students and parents assess where the student may need additional help prior to the higher impact assessment. **All standards reassessments must be completed seven school days prior to the end of the term.**

Below are the requirements that must be met in order for a student to reassess.

1. Students **must have completed all homework and in class assignments relating to the standard(s) that the assessment covered.**
2. Students **must complete some form of remediation.** The teacher is responsible for assigning this and the student must complete it by the deadline set by the teacher. This does not eliminate re-teaching by the teacher when necessary.
3. The reassessment must be requested by the student within one week of the assignment being returned. The reassessment date and time will be decided at that time. **Reassessments will take place before or after school.** Parents must sign a reassessment form indicating they are aware that the student needs to reassess for standards mastery.
4. Grade Level specific information will be provided by each grade.

The new score will replace the original score and a note made in the comments section indicating the original score. Please check Powerschool on a regular basis to monitor your child's progress.
